

A physician's medical evaluation report must be completed prior to admission to the program. Physical examination of the Member within three months prior to admission and at least annually thereafter is required. A tuberculosis skin test will be given as part of this examination and bi-annually thereafter. The result of the tuberculosis skin test must be negative. Should the skin test result be positive, a chest x-ray indicating no active disease must be done. Member and/or caregiver shall pay the cost of such physician visits.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- A. The Center shall provide the following services to Members who receive part-time or full-time day services. Services may vary according to each Member's plan of care.
 1. Nursing service, to provide treatment, health screening, health education, medication administering, dressing, and other care as needed.
 2. Recreational therapy, including but not limited to, music therapy, sensory stimulation, cognitive skills, and exercising.
 3. Supervision and assistance when necessary with activities of daily living, including toileting, feeding, and transferring.
 4. Meals, including therapeutic or modified diets as prescribed by a physician, to include one hot meal per day and two snacks.
 5. Other services may be added as pertinent to the plans of care for the Members.
